


DIRECTORY OF NAVAL TRAINING DEVICES



PARACHUTE - WATER DROP TRAINER, DEVICE 9F5

TRAINING CATEGORY:

PHYSIOLOGICAL TRAINING (Parachute)

ORIGINATING AGENCY:

DCNO/AIR

SECURITY CLASSIFICATION:

Device 9F5 is unclassified.

INTENDED USE:

To give instruction to aviation cadets, NAO's, midshipmen, and aircrewmembers in the proper procedures for a water landing in a parachute.

FUNCTIONAL DESCRIPTION:

Device 9F5 consists of a standard parachute harness, suspended by a line through a pulley over a swimming pool. After the student has been given instruction in the techniques used for a successful entrance into the water, the line is released by the instructor and the student completes his harness evacuation.

PHYSICAL INFORMATION:

The device is a fixed installation and is constructed to withstand constant use.

ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Parts are treated to withstand high humidity and constant use in and near water.

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED (NOT SUPPLIED):

Device 9F5 is used in conjunction with Device 9F2, Parachute Drag Trainer; and Device 9U44C, the Dilbert Dunker Ditching Trainer.

INSTALLATION AREA:

In an indoor pool.

Instructor: One (1) (with survival training)
Trainees: One to Twenty (1 - 20)
